## THE PROJECT WILL

- CONTRIBUTE to creating inclusive environment that foster equity and equality for people with disability.
- IMPROVE the job placement of young people with disability, by addressing the working barriers faced by them in accessing the working opportunities.
- DISPEL the myths related to the difficulties of job placement of apprentices with disabilities through the creation of a quality standard to be expected in order to develop a positive transnational remote apprenticeship experience.

A COMMUNITY OF PRACTICES based on virtual and local HUBS, Local Workshops and Campaigns and an EU Policy Recommendation.
